The mission of Elijah was plainly outlined. - It was to establish a bond of interest between the present and past generations, and to "turn the heart of the children to their fathers."

To be more process - the purpose of Elijah'sxmi coming was to create in the heartsm of living persons, and interest in their ancestors.

Since this purpose was so definitely stated and established by meripate scripture, it remains only for us to determine if he has yet come.

About one hundred forty years ago, the promise that the savior made in regard to the mission of Elijah, was fulfilled.

He appeared to the Prophet Joseph, and Oliver Cowdery, in the Temple at Kirtland, and there bestowed upon them the keys of the sealing power of the priesthood.

Without the coming of Elijah, there would be need for temples.

This coming of Elijah is one of the vital things in the history of this world. It is vital to every person who has ever lived upon the face of the earth.

It might be interesting to note that before that great event in 1836 - the appearance of Eligah to restore the keys of sealing, there was very little endeavor to search the records of the dead.

There were no organizations or societies that anyone seems to know about begore that important date in 1836.

One year later, however, in 1837, Great British passed laws that provided for and compelled the preservation of records of the dead.

In 1844, the New England Historical and Genealogical Society was organized in Boston and this could well be the first organization of this kind in the world.

In 1869, the New York Genealogical and Biographical Society in the Control of Man Form was organized.

Then followed rapidly other societies throughout the states then in existance.
